

Do Not Place These Items in Cart

No Plastic Bags

Placing recyclable material in plastic bags whether in large "blue bags" or single use shopping bags frequently contaminates the recyclables and causes equipment failure.

This program is hoping to reduce the use of plastic bags in the recycling process by 71,000 bags each year.

The bags can be not recyclable and have to be landfilled.

Recycle At The Curb

Tuesday

Place your cart at the curb by 7 am, and bring it in when empty. Set your cart along the edge of your street with the lid opening facing the street. Please leave at least 3 feet of space between your recycling cart and other objects (mail boxes, other carts, etc.).

Please make sure everything fits loosely in the cart so that items can be removed easily. Cardboard should be flattened. Large boxes should be flattened and left beside the cart.
