

# Food Truck Pilot Program Options

## Location

### Option 1

3399 Soco Road/Sweet Briar Lot across from the Festival Grounds (Up to four vendors)

### Option 2

Mary Rathbone Rich Park (One vendor space)

### Option 3

3399 Soco Road/Sweet Briar Lot across from the Festival Grounds (Up to four vendors)

Mary Rathbone Rich Park (One vendor space)

McCracken Corner Park (One vendor space)

## Days/Time

### Option 1

Monday-Wednesday 10:00 AM – 5:00 PM

### Option 2

Monday-Thursday 10:00 AM – 10:00 PM

### Option 3

Monday-Thursday 10:00 AM – 10:00 PM

1<sup>st</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays 10:00 AM – 8:00 PM (Currently no conflicts with Festival Grounds)

### Option 4

Any day 10:00 AM – 10:00 PM when special events are not scheduled at the Festival Grounds

## Permitting

### Option 1

Yearly fee of \$500 (Once approved, vendors operate on a first-come, first-served basis)

### Option 2

Monthly fee of \$75 (Once approved, vendors operate on a first-come, first-served basis)

### Option 3

Schedule/approve vendors using a fixed Calendar (Similar to reserving the Festival Grounds)

## Additional Standards

Liability Insurance (1 Million Dollar)

Vendor responsible for removal of all trash generated.

Generators required as no electrical hookups are available.

## Timeframe

### Option 1

~ 3 Months (Ending December 31, 2021)

### Option 2

~6 Months (Ending March 31, 2022)

### Option 3

~9 Months (Ending June 30, 2022)

# Other Pilot Programs

## Greensboro Pilot Program October/November 2012

1 Location accommodating up to four vendors in Public ROW

\$20 per day to operate

Weekdays 10-3 & Friday 10-3 and 5-10

Now regulated by the Code of Ordinances to also allow on Private Property in Commercial Districts

Not allowed 50 feet from the main entrance of any restaurant during business hours (unless authorized by a restaurant to be closer).

## Raleigh Pilot Program August 2016-January 2017

6 month trial period

4 Designated Zones-specified near employment locations lacking restaurants nearby

Weekdays 10-3, First Fridays 10-8

Prohibited from operating within 100 feet of restaurants

## Asheville Pilot Program January-December 2018

1 Location accommodating up to four vendors @ 68 Haywood

One-time \$50 application fee (same as application fee for special events on public property)

Proof of liability insurance

Description and dimensions of the truck or vending structure.

Once approved, vendors can operate on the site during its open hours (7 a.m. – 10 p.m. daily) on a first-come, first-served basis, when other outdoor special events are not scheduled at the site.

Required to plug into the on-site electricity.

Vendor responsible for removal of trash generated.

Initially done as Outdoor Special Events. Feedback from food truck vendors said process was cost prohibitive for food truck/vendor uses not in association with an organized event. City Council directed City staff to create a new permit process.
